TITLE: CERTIFICATION INTERPROVINCIAL ENTITLEMENT 1.5

POLICY:

Regular and Associate One (1) Members that have relocated to British Columbia or the Yukon Territory from a different Canadian Province are eligible to apply for a comparable level of Certification.

1. Certification Applicants must request the level of Certification; provide the necessary work experience confirmations, certificates issued from ACBOA, OBOA or Alberta Safety Codes Council and other validation materials as required by the Registrar.
2. Upon Certification application completion, the Registrar will forward the application for approval to the Certification Committee and/or Chairperson.
3. The approved application will be confirmed by the Executive Committee by Motion at a BOABC Executive meeting and the result recorded in the Minutes of the BOABC Executive Meeting.

ACBOA

Canadian Certified Building Official – Housing: Regular and Associate One (1) members who have received the Canadian Certified Building Official Certification will be eligible to receive **BOABC Level One (1) Certification**.

Canadian Certified Building Official – Part 9: Regular and Associate One (1) members who have received the Canadian Certified Building Official Certification will be eligible to receive **BOABC Level Two (2) Certification**.

Canadian Certified Building Official – Part 3: Regular and Associate One (1) members who have received the Canadian Certified Building Official Certification will be eligible to receive **BOABC Level Three (3) Certification**.

OBOA

LEVEL 1 Certified: Regular and Associate One (1) members who have received the OBOA Level One Certification will be eligible to receive **BOABC Level One (1) Certification** upon completion of the BOABC legal course.

Certified Building Code Official (CBCO): Regular and Associate One (1) members who have received the Certified Building Code Official (CBCO) Certification will be eligible to receive **BOABC Level Three (3) Certification** upon completion of the BOABC legal course. This meets the reciprocal agreement that is in place between the OBOA and the BOABC.

Alberta Safety Codes Council

Building Group A Level 1 (Housing and Small Buildings): Regular and Associate One (1) members who have received the Building Group A Level 1 (Housing and Small Buildings certification will be eligible to receive **BOABC Level One (1) Certification.**

Building Group A Level 2 (Buildings – Except Institutional – high-rise and special): Regular and Associate One (1) members who have received the Building Group A Level 2 (Buildings – Except Institutional – high rise and special) Certification will be eligible to receive **BOABC Level Two (2) Certification.**

Building Group A Level 3 (Buildings – all uses & Occupancies): Regular and Associate One (1) members who have received the Building Group A Level 3 (Buildings – all uses & occupancies) Certification will be eligible to receive **BOABC Level Three (3) Certification.**

Other

Regular and Associate One (1) members who have received certification from Canadian Provinces other than Ontario and Alberta and who do not hold certification with ACBOA will be reviewed on an individual basis.

POLICY OBJECTIVE:

To facilitate the desire of Members to have the opportunity to relocate to British Columbia or the Yukon Territory using their certification obtained in another Canadian Province.

POLICY JUSTIFICATION:

Members, the Association, employers and the public require knowledge of the level of achievement of the holder of the Certificate. **Anticipates conformity to a BOABC liscensing regulatory procedure**
