POLICY:

The International Code Council grades Association examinations and provides results by way of a computerized program. The scaled score required to pass each examination is 80%. The ICC and the Association will indicate examination results to candidates by providing a scaled score for all examination candidates that achieve 80%, or above, in an examination.

The Association will advise candidates, who do not achieve a scaled score of 80% or above. Those examination candidates will not be provided with their scaled score. All candidates will be informed of the areas requiring study in the examination report.

POLICY OBJECTIVE:

To provide examination candidates passing the examination with an indicator of the scaled score achieved on the examination.

POLICY JUSTIFICATION:

This is in keeping with a motion, passed at the 03 May 1995 Annual General Meeting, that the policy of indicating "Pass" was not informative enough.
