

'The BC Legal, Regulatory System & the Code of Ethics Course for Building Officials'

This is the first course providing basic knowledge of the regulatory system in BC and the role of Building Officials as prescribed in the Code of Ethics. Comments from course participants include: "I have been doing this job for fifteen years and no one ever explained this to me";

"Duty of Care - I never knew this"; and "It's about time the Association put these courses on".

Upon completion of the course a participant should be able to undertake the following:

- Identify the different Acts and Regulations related to the job function of a Building Official and understand how they control activities;
- Understand how roles and responsibilities are created;
- Identify how Building Officials create a 'Duty of Care';
- Comprehend how to work and behave within the BOABC Code of Ethics and how the legal profession views the role of the Building Official.

To obtain the Certificate of Completion and to accumulate the five [5] Continuing Professional Development, CPD points, a written test will be administered at the end of the course, with a one hour time frame to complete.

The Instructor is the BOABC Education Coordinator, Herman Koolman, RBO.
