POLICY:

A person may take the BOABC Level One (1) examination provided that he/she has successfully completed a Part 9 course created by the BOABC, or a similar course provided by a recognized institution endorsed by the BOABC, within one year of having completed that course of study.

The conditions of completing and passing all BOABC examinations by students and non-members shall be the same conditions as those, which apply to Members of the Association.

POLICY OBJECTIVE:

To provide candidates, who are not members of BOABC, and are enrolled in defined building code courses, an opportunity to write the BOABC Level One examination as a measure of their code knowledge.

POLICY JUSTIFICATION:

This is in keeping with the BOABC objective to provide education and examinations to users of the B.C. Building Code and to provide assistance to persons wishing to gain code knowledge in the hope, or expectation, of entering the field of a code practitioner.
