Old School: Courses for Building Conservation . . .

is a custom designed, continuing education certificate program that brings together the theory and practice of heritage building conservation. Courses are designed for a mixed audience of construction trades, design professionals, building owners, local government officials and the interested public.

Instructors are working professionals who are experts in their fields of planning, architecture, heritage conservation, construction, landscape architecture, & specific building elements such as windows and masonry. Professional development credits are granted to Architects, Planners, Building Officials, Appraisers & Landscape Architects. Approximately 25% of registrants take the courses for professional development credits from the AIBC; PIBC; BCSLA; AIC-BC + BOABC.

In 2009 (the second year of the program), 125 people registered for Old School courses.

In addition many more people registered for on-going VHF programs that are eligible for Old School credit such as the Heritage House Tour, Vancouver Special Tour, and Walking Tours. 75% of students live within the city of Vancouver and 25% live in Metro Vancouver and around Southwestern BC.

Courses are held evenings and weekends in venues around Vancouver, and vary in length from 2.5 to 8 hours. Most courses have multiple instructors to ensure various points of view are presented. The courses are interactive and where possible there is a hands-on component, or an opportunity to visit a heritage building site or neighbourhood with instructors.
