

The BC Legal, Regulatory System and the Code of Ethics for Building Officials

The BOABC is providing a new course on the basic knowledge of the BC Legal, Regulatory System and the Code of Ethics for Building Officials.

The first offering of this course will be provided in two locations on Vancouver Island:

- Monday September 13, 2010, City of Nanaimo, Municipal Annex Training Room, 238 Franklyn Avenue: 8:30 am to 5:00 pm.
- Tuesday September 21, 2010, Town of Sidney, 2nd Floor Sidney Fire Hall, 9873 Third Street: 8:30 am to 5:00 pm.

To obtain the Certificate of completion and to accumulate the five [5] Continuing Professional Development, CPD points, a written test will be administered at the end of the course with a one-hour time frame to complete.

Upon course completion a participant should be able to do the following:

- Identify the different Acts and Regulations related to the job function of a Building Official and understand how they control activities;
- Have an understanding how roles and responsibilities are created;
- Identify how Building Officials create a 'Duty of Care';
- Understand how to work and behave within the BOABC Code of Ethics and how the legal profession views the role of the Building Official.
